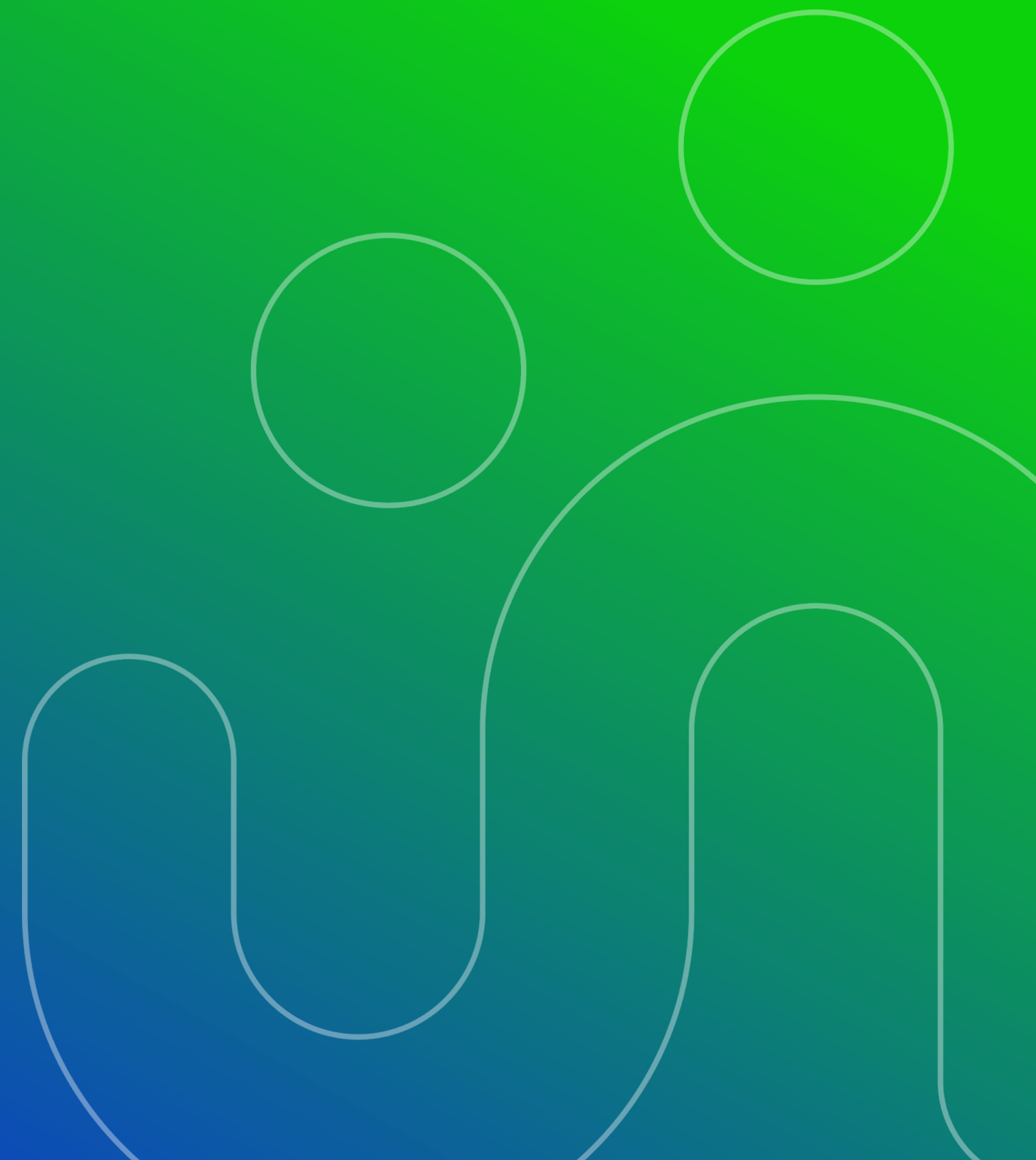

Information to applicants

- Two types of projects: small-scale & regular
- Up to 65% Interreg funding for EU partners
- Up to 50% IR funding for Norwegian partners
- Simplifications in budgeting and reporting
- Budget specified per partner
- Co-financing can be private and/or public
